Roger DeCoster spent the first half of his career as a professional motocross racer. The Belgian born Champion won five 500cc Motocross World Championships, tallied numerous race wins and an International Six Day Trail gold medal. His racing success lead him to be one of the most successful motocross riders of his era encouraging fans to brand him with the nickname 'The Man.' DeCoster ended his racing career on top, winning his final World Championship race at the end of the 1980 season.

Following his successful racing career, DeCoster moved to the United States where he took his first team managing job for Honda and later Suzuki. After 15 successful years with Suzuki, DeCoster switched to the Red Bull/KTM Team for 2011 where he hopes to continue his tradition of success with his KTM Team riders and the new line of KTM SX models.
